

1. Remove items from jar and screw the lid back on. 
2. Turn upside down.
3. Choose which way the jar will face when completed and mark the lid (with a pencil or piece of tape found at home. This will help you to glue your figurine facing the correct way later).
4. Design your scene (the inside of the lid will be the bottom of your snow globe). Use beads, jewels, confetti, or other items found around the house.
5. Glue items in place. (See warnings included in kit. **DO NOT ATTACH ANYTHING TO THE INSIDE EDGES OF THE LID.** You want to ensure the lid will close tightly. Make sure to **SAVE SOME GLUE** for later!)
6. Let dry.
7. Fill jar with water. (Distilled water will be clearest, but tap will work fine!) Leave some room so you can shake the water around.
8. Add pom poms, confetti, and glitter to the water (pinch the pom poms in the water so they absorb it and float to the bottom). **A LITTLE GLITTER GOES A LONG WAY!**
9. Wrap half of the white thread seal tape around the jar opening.
10. Screw lid back on jar and use the remaining thread seal tape to wrap over the lid where it meets the jar (you can also use other kinds of tape found at home).
11. Slowly turn the jar upside down over a sink or bowl. If there are any leaks, use the super glue to seal them and let dry. **HOT GLUE** also works well if available. 
12. Wrap the ribbon around the tape and tie a bow!
